(COMMUNITY OF MILD MAY)
NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT

THE PROJECT:

The Municipality of South Bruce is planning to construct a new sanitary sewer to service lands being developed for residential purposes in the south end of the community of Mildmay. The proposed gravity sewer would generally extend along the route of the Bruce County Rail Trail, between the sewage pumping station located on Jane Street South westerly to Absalom Street West (refer to the accompanying key plan).

THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS:

The project is following the planning process established for Schedule B activities under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) document. Schedule B projects are approved subject to a screening process. The purpose of the screening process is to identify any potential environmental impacts associated with the proposal and to plan for appropriate mitigation of any impacts. This process includes consultation with the public, stakeholders and review agencies.
