Focus on Youth - U30

- Must be a South Bruce Youth (under 30 years old)
- Pre-approval of the request/application is required
- Proof of registration or purchase is required
- Limited funds are available
- Requests/applications are dependent on funding received for the program
- Funding opportunities include, but are not limited to, support for:
 - South Bruce Schools:
 - workshops and learning experiences based on science, math, environment and trades
 - school sports
 - snack programs
 - STEM resources
 - investments in robotics tools or programs
 - transportation to Ontario Skills Competition or similar events
 - environmental tool kits or similar initiatives (i.e. growing, composting etc.)
 - Sports activities/clubs
 - o Summer camp or workshop with a focus on science/math/environment
 - o Traditional knowledge related education
 - Environmental projects through funding for youth workers to gain experience in a community project.

Focus on Community

- Must be a South Bruce resident, organization, community service club or business
- Pre-approval of the request/application is required
- Proof of registration or purchase is required
- Limited funds are available
- Requests/applications are dependent on funding received for the program
- Funding opportunities include, but are not limited to, support for:
 - Workshops for general skills development (i.e. Computer literacy courses, AutoCAD, business planning, basic bookkeeping, first aid and CPR training, project planning and management, meeting facilitation and /or conflict resolution, communications training, customer service, etc.)
 - o Skills training programs
 - Tradespeople in community service areas needed by the community (i.e. plumbing, electrician, personal support workers etc.)
 - Assistance with registration fees (in the form of a partial refund proof of completion required)
 - Assistance with required course materials (i.e. text books, tools, etc.)
