Public Works

Some general reminders from your Public Works Department:

LOCATES - When excavating anything on your property you must contact Ontario One-Call at 1-800-400-2255 or visit www.on1call.com. They will locate municipal water, sewer, hydro, gas and telephone.

ENTRANCE PERMITS - If you are installing a new entranceway to a property (both rural and urban) an entrance permit is required. A \$600.00 refundable deposit will be required at the same time as the \$75.00 fee.

MANURE, ROCKPILES AND BRUSH - Anyone who puts any type of garbage, manure, rocks or brush into or onto the roads or road allowances will be asked to remove it immediately. If it is not removed, the Municipality will remove it at the owner's expense.

Finance

Reminder that Property Taxes are due (4th instalment) in a couple weeks! The following Payment Options are encouraged:

- You can pay your Accounts Receivable Invoices through your online banking. Use your 5-digit Customer number at the top of your Invoice. You will have a different Customer Number for each Billing Department.
- You can pay your property taxes through your online banking. Each property Roll Number must be set up each separately as an account.
- You can pay through e-transfer. Contact the Municipal Office for further details.

Community Liaison Committee

The South Bruce CLC held another virtual monthly meeting on October 8th. In case you missed it, here are some highlights:

- The Committee welcomed two presentations; Megan Moore, Operations Research Analyst at the Canadian Nuclear Laboratories and Caitlin Burley, Manager of Transportation Engagement at the Nuclear Waste Management Organization.
- Megan Moore detailed the results of a study which she was a part of in 2016 that looked at the feasibility of recycling CANDU Fuel and outlined some of the challenges it identified.
- Caitlin Burley presented information on the NWMO's draft Transportation Planning Framework, and pointed to ways input could be given.
- Approximately 34 members of the public attended the meeting over Zoom, and had the opportunity to ask questions to the educational presenters. Community members could also listen to the meeting over the phone.

Building Department

Frequently Asked Question: Why do I need a building permit?

A Building Permit provides the means to review the project designs, to inspect the actual construction and to ensure that the health, safety and welfare of the occupants of the building are maintained. By reviewing and approving plans before any work is done ensures that construction within the Municipality of South Bruce complies with the Ontario Building Code (which sets minimum standards for design and materials), the local zoning by-law (which controls building location, height, parking, etc. and uses that are suitable to the area) and other applicable laws.

A building permit is a formal approval to construct, add to, or renovate a building on your property. Building permits allow the municipality to protect the interests of both individuals and the community as a whole.
