Apply for Your Permit Online!



The Municipality of South Bruce is pleased to offer residents, builders, and the business community Cloudpermit - an online system to apply for and track your building permits.

The Cloudpermit building permit system allows you to apply for and to see the status of your application anywhere, at any time. You can start an application and finish it later, and receive email updates on the status of your permit application. You can even request building inspections!

Cloudpermit provides a Support Page that walks you step by step on how to create an account, how to create and submit applications, how to access your building permit, and much more!

Permit applications will still be accepted by mail, email, or in person at the Municipal Office by printing and completing all the required forms and submitting them with your project drawings.

## Clerk's Office

### Marriage License

A Marriage License is a required official permit that enables the couple to have a Marriage ceremony. This is a prerequisite in obtaining an official Marriage Certificate from the Province. The Municipality of South Bruce issues marriage licenses that can be used to marry anywhere in Ontario. Marriage Licenses may be obtained at the Municipality of South Bruce. The fee is \$125. Bring the completed application and your birth certificates for verification. If you have been divorced you must bring in the original or certified copy of the divorce decree. A Marriage License can only be issued within 90 days of the wedding date.

Approximately three months after the marriage ceremony, you are advised to apply for a marriage certificate. This paperwork is required for anyone wishing to assume the name of their current spouse, apply for pension and a variety of other reasons.
