CHRISTMAS IS COMING and with that so does the packaging material. We are working towards a new polystyrene recycling program at the landfill sites & we need your help!

Please separate your polystyrene and ensure it is clean and dry.

Acceptable Material:

- White, rigid, expanded polystyrene packaging from electronics, appliances, tools, toys, etc.
- Please remove all tape, plastic, stickers, cardboard and other contaminants attached to the foam.

NOT Acceptable Material:

- Take-out containers, meat trays, coffee cups
- Packing peanuts
- Construction insulation, blue and pink
- Polyethylene and polypropylene, pool noodles
- Hot tub cover inserts
