You receive a customized online store, hands on assistance with setting up and launching your store, training support which includes digital marketing, shipping and inventory management, and access to free tools to help support the launch of your online store – all for FREE! Businesses will be responsible for the monthly Shopify fee after the initial 90-day trial.
- If you haven't already applied for the South Bruce Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) Grant, there are still funds available! A simple application that takes 5 minutes and a copy of your receipts is all it takes to recoup some of your expenses during COVID to keep everyone safe.
